Berthoud Community Fund Committee Grants Over \$28,000

The Community Foundation of Northern Colorado is awarding over \$28,000 to nonprofit agencies that directly serve Berthoud residents.

The Foundation's Berthoud Community Fund Committee provides input to its Trustees and staff and is responsible for grantmaking from unrestricted funds established for the benefit of the Berthoud community. Each fall, this local committee carefully reviews and grant requests submitted by charitable organizations and recommends the distribution of available funds to achieve the greatest impact. The committee encourages funding requests that build community engagement within the Berthoud community, preserve the entire Berthoud community as a great place to live and raise kids, and achieve obvious and meaningful outcomes. Since 1996, more than \$475,000 has been distributed from the Berthoud Community Fund to nonprofits serving Berthoud residents.

Organizations receiving grants are Berthoud CARES, Berthoud Golden Links – Project RAFT, Berthoud Habitat for Humanity, Berthoud Historical Society, Christmas in Berthoud, First United Methodist Church of Berthoud, Friends of the Berthoud Public Library, House of Neighborly Service, Meals on Wheels of Loveland and Berthoud, and Wildfire Community Arts Center.
